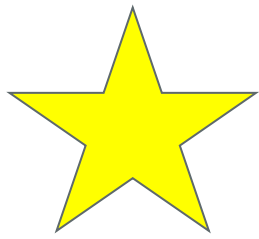

What is our role in school ?



- Our role is to make everyone SPEAK MORE WELSH! :-)
We come up with lots of ideas during the year to try and help increase the use and enjoyment of Welsh.
- We measure how we are doing by choosing 4 different children to stop at the door, after playtime and after dinner time, and we ask them questions in Welsh, linked to the pattern we are practising throughout the school, every month.
For example, this month we are revising our numbers, right from the infants to Year 6 in our daily Welsh.
So we can ask them to tell us numbers, to ask and answer questions about their birthday, to tell us how old they are.

We have a Gwasanaeth, a Praise Assembly every Friday where we award the best student, teacher and class taken from the tallies that we have collected that week.

We give a Welsh certificate to

We record the best class on the graph in the hall, weekly, and the class that wins the most tallies each term, has an afternoon to choose what they want to do!

- This month we are learning about **numbers** across the school, so we and teach our school a new game, such as milk shake, or jumping rope, or find the number, all in Welsh!
